

Electricity Supply for Schools – contract renewals

Towards the end of September 2017, the Office of Government Procurement (OGP) sent information and contract documents in relation to the appointment of a new electricity provider for all school currently under contract within the OGP bundle. Further notifications issued to these schools reminding them to sign (i) the goods contract; (ii) confidentiality agreement; and (iii) the account set up form, and send all three to the new provider, Energia (smeAccountManager@energia.ie) by the end of October 2017. Completing the administration process at this early stage facilitates the smooth transfer of school accounts from the current supplier to Energia by 1st May 2018, the commencement date of the new contract.



School Payments Pilot Project

Currently underway is the evaluation process which critically examines the proposals received from the market for the delivery of a comprehensive range of user-friendly payment solutions which makes the sending (by parents) of payments to school for school-based activities, and the receiving of those payments in the schools, more flexible for both parents and the school. The successful delivery of this project should go some way towards reducing the number of cash payments into the schools themselves, yet would not remove the cash payment option for those parents who prefer that option. The projected availability of these solutions to the schools is now Q1 2018
